Creative Curriculum Theme – 'Marvellous Me'

Personal, Social and Emotional

- Establish a clear routine and develop positive relationships with familiar adults and children.
- Share own likes and interests as part of a group.
- Talk about own family, friends and experiences.
- Explore emotions, feelings, sharing and turn taking.

Understanding the World

- Explore similarities and differences between ourselves, our family and friends.
- Notice detailed features of objects in the environment on an 'Autumn hunt' in Forest School.
- Use the computer to create a family picture.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Create a self portrait using different mark making materials.
- Draw pictures of family and friends.
- Learn and sing a variety of songs and Nursery rhymes.

English

We will read stories about feelings and sharing such as, 'Sometimes I feel sunny' by Gillian Shields, 'Cowboys can be kind' by Timothy Knapman and different traditional tales including 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' and 'The Three Little Pigs'.

- Develop interest in books, recall events and talk about characters.
- Play listening games to identify and compare sounds
- Explore mark making in a variety of ways.

Maths

- Develop an interest in number through counting games.
- Explore numbers in the environment including house numbers.
- Explore sorting and sharing with different objects and counting apparatus.
- Create a 'my house' shape picture.

Physical Activity

- Use a variety of tools and equipment at our 'Fine motor station' to develop pencil grip and control.
- Explore movement through use of the outdoor areas.; including Forest School.

Music

- Join in with songs and rhymes.
- Explore musical instruments and their different sounds.
