

## Footprint

Footprint explores the natural world and the impact that humans have on it. This concept looks at the ideas around sustainability and our future, including learning about physical and human features and changes to our planet. We discuss and debate issues such as global warming, conservation and sustainability.



## Civilisation

This concept explores the characteristics of a particular time or place that led to significant change or advancement. We explore how societies were formed based on colonisation, settlements, trade and how this impacted a particular place in time and the legacies left today.



## Culture

Culture explores the ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular group of people or society. We make comparisons and celebrate similarities and differences. We explore customs and how beliefs lead to traditions.

## Discovery

This concept explores the pursuit of innovation, both now and in the past. We look at how discovery and exploration leads to new thinking, inventions or modernisation. We learn about how things around us work – including our own bodies. This concept has a strong STEM focus.



## Relationships

This concept explores our own identity and the relationship we have with ourselves (our thoughts and feelings). We discuss communities, families and celebrate similarities and differences. We learn about the importance of respect and tolerance.



## Conflict and Resolution

This concept explores issues that cause conflict, how conflict can lead to change and how lasting legacies impact society today.
