There will be no forest school this half term.



This half term, our focus in Maths will be: Money, Multiplication and Division.

We will learn how to:

There are two types of reading book that your child will bring home:


A Little Wandle reading practise book **or** Accelerated reader book—This will be at the correct phonic stage for your child. They should be able to read this fluently and independently.

Wider Curriculum:

Our focus this half term will be History. Throughout our history lessons, we will learn about significant monarchs over time and develop our understanding of chronology.

Our DT will link to our Science, as we explore the importance of a healthy diet and create a healthy, balanced meal.

We will develop our musical skills and learn more songs on the ocarina.

Science:

In our science lessons, we will classify plants, animals and objects according to whether they are alive, dead or never alive.

We will also understand the basic needs of animals and humans for survival.

PSHE - Me and my safety

In PSHE, we will describe ways of keeping safe, including basic road safety.

RE - Worship and Ceremonies

Our RE lessons will help us to Identify symbolic actions, gestures and rituals and talk about how they are used as part of worship and ceremonies.
