We have two vacancies - the hours are between 3:30pm to 5:30pm OR 3.30pm - 6.00pm.

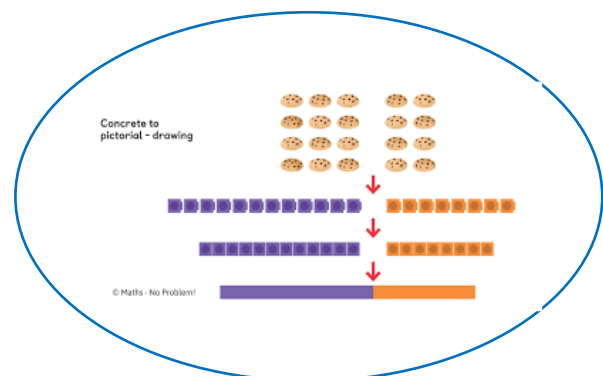
